



### Resin Filled Bezel Charms

**May 13 6-9PM \$45**

Bring your own small images (Color or B&W copied on paper) or use some of our pre-printed images to fill a metal bezel to make a pendant or charm for a bracelet! The image is then covered with clear resin for a glass like finish. Other techniques include adding glitter, beads or other small bits for a mixed media design. Kit includes: 2 bezels, images and resin. Please bring: Images (.5-1.5 inch in size), scissors, glitter, small beads or other goodies to decorate your image if desired.



### Basic Wire Techniques for Beading

**May 27 6-9PM \$35**

Learn professional techniques to make wire wrapped loops, earrings, links and jump ring attachments. The class will cover various wire techniques, tools and tips for anyone interested in jewelry making. These are the basics everyone needs to know for basic jewelry design. Kit includes: Practice wire, jump rings and beads. Please bring: 2 pair of chain nose pliers, wire cutters and round nose pliers if you have them. If not, you can borrow tools.



### ITS Transfers on Sea Glass

**June 17 6-9PM \$45**

Learn how to transfer images onto sea glass using ITS transfer medium. The class includes transfer techniques for other surfaces in addition to glass, such as metal, tile and more. Learn how to drill holes through the glass to make a pendant. Kit includes: 3 glass pieces, ready to use images, transfer medium to use and drill bit. Please bring scissors.



### Image Transfers on Metal Clay

**June 19 9AM-4PM \$135**

Learn basics of PMC silver and create pendants or bracelet plaques to which images will be applied. After firing and finishing your pieces, a special transfer solution and paper allow you to transfer laser images to the surface of the metal. Images will be provided. The finished pieces are durable and have a timeless, ethereal look. This is a project workshop, with finished pieces ready to attach to chain with jump rings you can bring from home. Kit includes: PMC silver, supplies for working/finishing PMC, images prepared for use, transfer solution. Please bring: scissors. Optional: small cookie or clay cutters, objects to texture metal clay if desired such as rubberstamps, buttons, lace etc.



### Etching on Metal

**June 25 9AM-4PM \$110**

In this workshop you will learn everything you've ever wanted to know about etching metal including new technology that uses easy, non-hazardous solutions for electro-etching! Learn how to etch on copper, brass, sterling silver—even metal clay! The class will include a copper shape/sheet that can be used to make a finished piece. The etched sheet can be cut to make jewelry pieces or used as a press mold for polymer or metal clay. Learn a variety of resist methods including simple ways to doodle on the metal. As a bonus, the class will include how to punch holes in the copper and then a riveting demonstration. Kit includes: Copper, images, etching supplies. Please bring: scissors, small paintbrush



### Metal Clay 101 - Charms

**June 26 9AM-4PM \$135**

Make metal clay charms using a variety of texturing tools including found objects, stamps, fabric, lace and leather tools. Replicate textures and collectables such as antique buttons by making silicone rubber molds to use with PMC. The class also includes how to add a patina to the silver to emphasize the details of the texture. The finished charms are richly embellished and ready to attach to a bracelet or chain. Kit includes: Metal Clay, metal clay supplies for working and finishing. Please bring: Small paintbrush, X-acto knife or other craft knife, textures such as rubberstamps or old buttons, clay cutters or other tools for clay if you have them.



### Resin Casting and Bezels

**July 10 9AM-4PM \$110**

Learn resin casting to make jewelry pieces such as pendants or bangle bracelets! This class covers all basic techniques for mixing, curing and finishing resin. Explore how to create colorful effects with dyes and pigments or embed inclusions into transparent resin. Students will learn mold making as well as how to use existing molds to create a variety of finished pieces. Kit includes: Mold, bezel, resin, colorants, inclusions, finishing supplies, gloves, dust mask. Please bring: Apron or old shirt to protect clothing, inclusions such as glitter, buttons, brass findings, paper, sea shells or other small objects to embed in the resin.
